Dr Hala Georges gained her Master's Degree in Graphic Design from The University of Creative Arts – UK followed by a Ph.D. in Creative Arts from The University of Brighton - UK. Dr Georges is a Member of the Editorial Board of The International Journal of Literature & Arts and an industry reviewer at The One Club for Creativity - New York. Alongside her teaching experience at universities across Europe, the UK, and the Middle East, her work has been exhibited internationally in the USA, Spain, Portugal, Germany, Switzerland, UK, Italy, Canada, and the UAE among others. Recent projects include "Seoul Speaks Arabic" public display in South Korea and "Mixing Identities" exhibition in the 60th Venice Biennale. She is also the founder of @arabic_graphicdesign platform dedicated to archiving and sharing current trends of Arabic graphic design. Her students have achieved top honors in international competitions, including the Creative Conscience and D&AD London Awards in 2023 and 2024. Georges is currently writing "A Quarter-Century of Arabic Graphic Design | Post 2000" book with the help of SEED Grant from The University of Sharjah. Dr. Georges is an Assistant Professor of Visual Communication.
